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The results of the 2024 NECO BECE have been another milestone for our school, with many of our JSS 3 intellects achieving distinction, Alhamdulillah. Immediately after completing their Basic Education Certificate Examination, our JSS 3 intellects were placed on our Pre-SS 1 programme to facilitate their transition into senior secondary school and to determine their suitable academic field of study.

We have commenced monthly mock examinations of WAEC standard for the current SS 2 class to adequately prepare them for the forthcoming GCE in November. Additionally, all SS 2 intellects will be required to attend a GCE coaching

session during the summer school programme from August 5th to September 6th. This examination will ultimately familiarize them with the standard of external examinations and best prepare them for the 2025 WAEC and NECO examinations.

By consistently monitoring the academic progress of all intellects in JSS 1, JSS 2 and SS 1, we identified those needing academic improvement and promptly assigned them to a specific facilitator for closer attention. This initiative aims to enhance their academic performance.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR PROGRAMMES



Our extra-curricular activities for the term included the following: **Club and House Meetings:** Club meetings were held every Friday from 12:05 pm to 1:05 pm while House meetings were held every Wednesday from 3:00 pm to 4:05 pm. The following clubs were active throughout the term: Event and Catering Management Club, Young Farmers Club, STEAM Club, Islamic Calligraphy Club, Blogging and Press Club, Literary and Debate Club.

During the House meetings on Wednesdays, house members

were prepared for an inter-house competition held within the term. The houses respectively are: Red House (Umar bn Khattab), Blue House (Abubakr), Green House (Uthman bn Affan) and Yellow House (Ali bn Abi Talib).



Inter-house Debate: This term, the four houses competed in a debate titled “Examination Malpractice: A Scourge in Our Society.” Each
